A few things to keep in mind before you fill out our application:

- Our goal is to make the best match for fosters and our equines. Please fill out the application as fully and honestly as possible.
- Please note that your foster(s) cannot be relocated from the original approved facility without our permission. We reserve the right to do periodic “barn” checks.
- All of our horses must live in an environment with at least one other equine. Horses are herd animals and they require equine companionship.

Once your application has been received, we will set up an interview with you, check your references and schedule an appointment to inspect the property where the horse will be kept. The information will be reviewed and a final decision will be made. Fox Lea Farm reserves the right to deny fostering for any reason at its sole discretion. If you are approved, we will match you with a suitable equine(s). If we do not have a suitable equine at the time of approval, your approved foster application will be kept on file. A signed foster contract will be required.
